Footnotes

CALL TO GLORY was urged to secure a forward placing along the rail in the opening quarter, attended the pace for a half, pressed the issue to go well clear racing through the turn and held sway to the end under steady pressure. PIANO MAGIC reserved outside foes off the second flight, commenced a steady advance on the turn, angled out five wide after six furlongs and continued with a steady effort to prove best of the others. HONEST PROPHET, allowed to settle off the inside for five furlongs, gradually drew into contention racing three deep on the bend, steadied off rivals entering upper stretch, shifted out five wide racing through the lane but continued with interest to close the gap and earn a share. MILITARY LEGEND was guided to the rail early tracking just off the second flight, saved ground on the bend, came through inside foes to challenge in upper stretch, made some progress to close the gap but was outkicked for a share. TOQUINHO, held up between foes just off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out on the bend to challenge four deep between foes after six furlongs but finished evenly in the final stages. GAGE PARK shifted a bit off the inside while gaining a position in the second flight, made a brief bid between foes nearing upper stretch but quickly emptied out. CHIEF SOMERSET tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight, made some brief progress in that path racing through the turn but came up empty entering upper stretch. POOR JOHN was never a factor. GRATTAN STREET, prominent between foes in the opening stages, pressed the issue outside the winner racing to the turn and quickly gave way. MR. SEABRA flashed brief pace while racing well wide in the opening half but quickly dropped out of contention.
