Footnotes

FOXIE'S BOY was urged to the lead along the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin into the bend and held sway to the end while being kept to steady pressure. TWYLAS RED CAT broke inwards bumping INTENSLYCONFUZZLED, was settled off the second flight, circled foes four wide racing into upper stretch and proved best of the others. REPENT N RECEIVE tracked the pacesetter just off the second flight along the inside racing to the bend, steadily moved to striking distance entering the bend, shifted outside the pacesetter to challenge in upper stretch but couldn't gain terms with that foe while being outfinished for second. BRAIN TEAZE tracked off the second flight between foes near the inside and made an effort to improve his position racing into the stretch. HOUSE OF WORDS tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail racing to the bend, saved ground on the bend and continued evenly into the stretch. CUBAN MISSILE tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, then emptied out in upper stretch. MUSIC SEEKER was never a factor. BULLBUCK tracked the pacesetter three wide in the second flight racing into the turn but was through after a half. INTENSLYCONFUZZLED, bumped at the start, settled into stride and never menaced thereafter.
