Footnotes

LIVE FROM APPOLLO was urged to the fore from between foes racing through the backstretch, dictated the pace along the inside on the turn, shook clear racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. ASHTONOFUN, held up out of close quarters early, circled foes four wide racing into upper stretch and proved best of the others. HAPMAN, prominent along the rail in the opening stages, tracked the pacesetter inside a rival in the second flight racing into the bend and finished evenly in late stages while prevailing for a share. UPSELL, in close attendance to the pace three deep early, chased the pacesetter into upper stretch but weakened in late stages when failing to gain terms. BARRACUDA BAY tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, continued three deep between foes on the bend, angled out four wide in upper stretch and continued evenly. BIGTIME MAC tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside racing to the turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. COLLIDIN broke through the gate before the start, tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight but dropped out entering upper stretch.
