TOP SURPRISE exchanged some contact with EIGHTY MILLION at the start, was settled out of striking distance along the inside, shifted out on the backstretch, then made a sharp move to gain terms with the first flight four deep nearing the far turn, asserted himself to gain a narrow advantage in upper stretch and extended that margin in late stages under firm left handed encouragement. TABLE GAMES, held up off the leaders near the inside in the opening stages, came around foes racing through the far turn and proved best of the others. HUNGRY WILDCAT settled off the inside in the opening stages, swung four wide racing into upper stretch and continued to improve his position to the end. CROWN OF ARAGORN, reserved three deep in the second flight in the opening stages, angled inside foes entering the far turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, switched out to race between foes into the lane but had no final bid. VOUCH FOR VICTORY tracked just off the first flight racing to the backstretch, moved to press the issue three deep entering the far turn, dueled between foes into upper stretch and emptied out. EIGHTY MILLION exchanged contact with the eventual winner at the start, moved to terms with the pacesetter along the inside racing into the first turn, pressed the issue along the rail while racing in close quarters entering the far turn and emptied out in upper stretch. CHAMPION KID sped to the fore outside a rival racing to the first turn, pressed the pace between foes into the far turn while caught in tight quarters and steadily faded nearing midstretch. TRAGIC MAGIC, steadied out of tight quarters at the start, never menaced thereafter.
