SUMMER SAVORY bobbled at the start, was held up avoiding close quarters entering the first turn, shifted outside foes on the backstretch, made steady progress entering the far turn circling into contention five deep, wrested command in late stages and drew clear under firm encouragement. HUXLEY WINNER, reserved along the inside in the opening half, gathered momentum on the far turn, swung out five wide nearing upper stretch and continued with a steady response to prove best of the others. GINNY'S CLASSIC sped clear of the field while angling over, dictated the pace on a clear margin into upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum through the final furlong. BASILIO'S THUNDER was steadied a bit between foes while caught in close quarters entering the first turn, made some progress to split foes three wide racing through the far turn and improved her position to the end. HERE OUI GO AGAIN

settled near the inside in the opening half, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. AMERICA'S BLOSSOM, allowed to settle racing to the far turn, shifted off the inside in upper stretch and made some belated progress between foes. FIRST OF FEBRUARY tracked outside foes in the second flight, was urged to challenge while caught four wide racing through the far turn and steadily faded in the drive. BILL'S PRESENCE tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight, bobbed midway through the backstretch, angled out three deep entering the far turn but quickly came up empty racing into the lane. HOLY KROEMER ducked out at the start, was righted to track outside foes, worked her way to the rail midway through the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch and steadily retreated in the drive. ALL HER DUE was never a factor. DELIGHTFUL DAISY was urged to secure a forward placing tracking the pacesetter, made a brief bid entering the far turn but quickly emptied out. READYBDANCING settled along the inside racing to the backstretch and soon dropped out.
