Footnotes

TAWAARED went readily to the fore while angling to the rail, dictated the tempo under light rating to the backstretch, then responded when prompted to maintain that advantage leaving the far turn and held sway to the end under firm left handed encouragement. ST LIAMS HALO, a bit unruly in the gate, hopped in the air at the start losing position to his foes, made steady progress to regain contention while angling to the inside nearing the far turn, came inside foes to secure second in the drive but couldn't menace the winner. LAGUNA MOON was settled along the inside in the opening half, came around a tiring foe entering the far turn, then continued to late stages making mild progress along the rail. WULFGAR was held up outside a rival stalking the pacesetter from just out of striking position early, moved to challenge three deep on the far turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. GONDORF angled inwards to stalk just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, couldn't close the gap on that foe despite pressure leaving the far turn and steadily faded while drifting out a bit in late stages. KING BEE reserved along the inside early, never mounted a serious challenge. HIPPOCRATES JONES broke slowly and trailed throughout.
