Footnotes

GENTLE LANA tracked the leaders unhurried outside foes racing off the second flight early, made a steady advance to striking distance three deep nearing upper stretch and wore down FLYIN'FLIRT to narrowly prevail in the final stages under strong handling. The latter, pulling a bit in early stages, stalked just off the pacesetter in hand racing into the bend, moved to challenge nearing upper stretch, took over leaving the furlong marker, shifted out resisting the winner's challenge late and just failed to contain that foe. SPECTACULOUS, held up tracking the pace just off the inside early, bid between foes racing into upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while not quite matching terms with the top pair. TIMELESS MISS was hustled to the lead while angling over, couldn't sustain her momentum and gave way leaving midstretch. PRETTY IN MINK ducked inwards a bit at the start, was settled into stride but never gained contention. LAGUNA AMIGA, a bit slow into stride, never mounted a serious challenge. WESTERN SWEEP settled outside foes in the opening stages, was fanned five wide entering upper stretch but lacked response.
