Footnotes

BLUE CANOE, reserved in early stages while angling nearer the inside, gathered momentum nearing the bend, raced in hand while awaiting an opening on the turn, shifted outside foes leaving the midway point of the bend, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch but continued with a steady response to prevail in late stages under firm left handed encouragement. BIG BRUIN, held up off the second flight near the inside in the opening half, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes three wide and continued willingly between foes to narrowly prevail for second. COOL HEART tracked the leader four wide off the second flight racing to the bend, angled out on the turn to challenge six deep between foes nearing upper stretch, couldn't match the winner's final kick and was outfinished for second. GAVILAN angled inwards to track just off the first flight along the inside racing to the bend, came through to challenge along the rail when presented an opening nearing upper stretch but was outkicked. IRON CHAMP, reserved three deep between foes off the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out while being roused on the turn to bid five wide between foes nearing upper stretch, but continued evenly in the final furlong. WEDGEWOOD joined the pace between foes soon after the start, pressed the pace outside a rival into upper stretch and gave way. JUNIOR'S BOOST TOO settled along the inside from well out of striking distance for five furlongs, then improved his position inside foes. RULEROUS, urged to the lead along the inside, dueled for command racing into the turn and emptied out entering upper stretch. LIFT OFF broke sharply, angled inwards to track the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but steadily retreated entering upper stretch. SEA URCHIN settled between foes in the opening stages but proved no factor. LARKFLITE tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight, continued four deep between foes on the turn but was through after six furlongs.
