**Footnotes**

SON OF PEARL tracked off the second flight while shifting nearer to the inside in the opening stages, switched out three deep entering the bend making a steady advance to striking distance nearing upper stretch, switched inside the pacesetter nearing midstretch but continued with a steady late response to edge that foe under firm encouragement. BATTLE FACTS was hustled clear along the rail from the break, dictated the pace on a commanding margin racing through the bend, shifted off the rail nearing upper stretch and continued to drift a bit in the closing stages while failing to contain the winner. BORREN IDENTITY settled out of striking distance along the rail racing into the bend, saved ground to upper stretch, then switched out nearing the furlong marker while finding his best stride late to gain a share from between foes nearing the wire. LAVENDER CHRIS tracked off the second flight outside foes racing into the bend, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and had no final bid. M J WINKS, urged along chasing the pacesetter near the inside racing into the bend, emptied out nearing upper stretch. CLEAR THE COUNTER flashed brief pace four wide on the backstretch but retreated early. FRENCH COLONEL broke slowly and never gained contention. CHEVRONS chased the pacesetter between foes in the second flight racing into the turn and emptied out abruptly nearing the stretch. THORSON broke outwards, was held up avoiding close quarters early and never menaced thereafter.
