Footnotes

POLTERGEIST moved to gain a forward placing along the rail in the opening stages, stalked the leaders under some reserve as part of the second flight into the far turn, shifted out after six furlongs commencing a steady advance, drew on terms with the pacesetter nearing midstretch and prevailed under firm handling. ALL IN SLEW broke readily, stalked just off the pacesetter into the backstretch, pressed that foe into the far turn, took over nearing upper stretch, resisted the winner to late stages but came up second best. GARBURETOR, steadied a bit in tight quarters along the rail in midpack racing into the first turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch and continued to improve his position to the end. DEPUTY SREVA was settled near the inside in the opening half, angled outside foes on the far turn, was fanned four wide entering the stretch and made some belated progress. D' WILDCARD settled outside foes in the opening stages but never gained striking distance. LION'S CIRCLE was urged to the lead along the inside, dueled inside a rival into the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. OUGHTA BE MINE tracked the pace outside a rival in second flight in the opening half but came up empty racing through the far turn. UNBRIDLED VICAR shifted inwards in the opening stages, raced in tight quarters in the last flight early and soon faded from contention.
