Footnotes

DUNDALK DUST was settled off the inside in the opening stages, steadied off rivals while caught in tight quarters entering the first turn, shifted out entering the backstretch while under some reserve, circled foes four deep to challenge leaving the far turn, drifted inwards under pressure but took charge and went clear under steady prompting. PRETTY SLIC CHICK angled inwards to stalk just off the pacesetter under some reserve, pressed that foe on the far turn into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid but held well for the place. LIGHTHOUSE DANCER broke sharply, dictated the pace along the inside under rating, resisted a rival racing through the far turn but weakened late. HELLO JAKE tracked the leaders unhurried saving ground in second flight to the backstretch, shifted out nearing upper stretch but had no final kick. AIN'T NO SAINT bobbled at the start, was righted to track outside foes in the opening stages, continued under some reserve between foes after a half, raced in tight quarters while exchanging some contact with MISS SIPPY racing through the far turn and couldn't gain striking distance. MISS SIPPY swerved out at the start, was settled along the inside, raced in tight quarters exchanging some contact with a rival on the far turn and lacked any further response. LOSE NONE, held up off the leaders outside a rival tracking in second flight to the backstretch, briefly challenge the leaders on the far turn, drifted out nearing upper stretch and quickly gave way.
