FAIRY CAT was settled off the second flight while shifting in to race outside a rival in the opening quarter, commenced a steady advance three deep leaving the midway point of the turn, continued in that path through the stretch and produced a steady late response to prevail in time under firm left handed encouragement. KING DAVID, a bit outpaced along the inside early, gradually drew into contention while shifting off the inside racing into the turn, angled four wide racing into upper stretch and found his best stride late to close the gap outside foes while prevailing for place honors. SPECIAL EXCHANGE, urged to secure a forward placing in the opening stages, led the second flight outside a rival racing into the turn, was under steady pressure to close the gap between foes in late stages but was outkicked by the top pair. THERE'S NO TELLING worked his way to the inside to track well off the second flight racing into the turn, steadily gained contention splitting foes near midstretch, then shifted to the rail in late stages while continuing willingly to the end. LITTLE SHEIK sprinted clear of his foes along the rail soon after the break, held sway on a clear margin into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the final sixteenth. NO BULL JESS, urged along pursuing the pacesetter inside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn, lacked the needed final response and was steadied in close quarters late. SLAMMIN EASY tracked just off the second flight racing three deep into the turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
