**Footnotes**

PASCHENDALE, urged to a contending position three deep between foes racing into the first turn while shifting into the path of BOBBIE N HER GIRLS, continued with a steady bid to prompt a rival's pace racing into the far turn, took over nearing midstretch and drew clear under pressure. ENGLISH ACCENT was urged to dispute the lead along the rail racing into the first turn to gain a narrow advantage, alternated on the lead with the eventual winner dueling for command into upper stretch, proved no match in the last furlong but continued well enough to prevail for place honors. DIVA'S DIAMOND was guided to the inside early tracking behind the second flight, split foes advancing on the far turn, angled four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to improve position. SARA'S CAPE, caught five wide racing into the turn, was urged along to gain a position outside foes in the second flight, continued under pressure outside a rival pursuing the leaders into the stretch but lacked the needed final bid. BELLAMAYA, caught six wide in the opening stages, shifted in nearing the turn to track the pace three deep between foes while caught in some close quarters near the three quarter mile marker, shifted to the inside while making a brief advance to striking distance on the far turn but flattened out in the drive. BUSTED DREAMS tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside behind the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out entering upper stretch to race three deep between foes but had no final response. CHICA BONITA shifted in early to track just off the first flight between foes, was held up a bit in tight quarters racing into the backstretch, continued between foes to upper stretch but had no closing bid. BOBBIE N HER GIRLS, forced out by the eventual winner to race four wide into the first turn while shifting into the path of SARA'S CAPE, was shuffled back out of tight quarters nearing the three quarter mile marker and never menaced thereafter. DON'T CRY A TEAR briefly disputed the pace between foes racing to the backstretch but dropped out abruptly entering the far turn. EAGER EM shifted off the inside racing into the backstretch but never gained contention.
