Footnotes

GENTLEMANS CODE broke sharply, forced the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, held a narrow advantage while on his own courage racing through the bend and drew clear in the closing stages under firm handling. BET SEATTLE tracked the leaders between foes in second flight racing into the turn, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to prevail for place honors. MR. FLEXIBLE settled out of striking distance near the inside early, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch and was making belated progress. CALMER THAN YOU, urged to secure a forward placing from the break, pressed the pacesetter along the rail racing into the turn and gave way leaving midstretch. SILVER DANDY, held up when caught in tight quarters just after the start, settled into stride, switched out five wide in upper stretch and displayed some late interest. STIG'S DEPUTY tracked the leaders outside foes in second flight early, lodged a brief, three wide bid nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. ABSOLUTELYSTRIKING broke a step slowly, shifted out four wide racing into the turn while moving to a position just off the second flight, shifted in under pressure racing into the stretch but quickly came up empty in the drive. LITTLE KICK tracked the leaders between foes in second flight while within striking distance in the opening stages but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. SILKEN BO dropped out of contention early. W. B. SMUDGE stumbled at the start and never gained contention.
