MEGAWATTIE vied for the lead off rail, took the lead mid stretch then held off all late bids and prevailed. KISSIT was well placed inside, waited for room, split horses, altered course late and finished well for the place. PARTY OF EIGHT was fractious in the gate, loomed a threat but was not good enough. GOLD SPIKE vied for the lead between horses then weakened late in the drive. BETTERN BISCUITS was off a step slow, swung wide in the turn and had no rally. VALERIES VALENTINE was unruly in the gate, hopped at the start and failed to menace. LUCKY WOMAN rushed up, vied for the lead inside and tired late. RACE RUN IN LANE 1.
