KITCHEN BOSS, within striking distance early, tracked the leaders along the inside as part of the second flight racing to the far turn, continued under patient handling awaiting an opening racing into upper stretch, came through close quarters to bid between foes nearing the furlong marker, altered course when losing her path to SUGAR KATE leaving midstretch and continued with a steady late bid to narrowly prevail between foes under firm handling. BREWMISTRESS tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out four wide to bid between foes racing into upper stretch and continued to contest the issue between foes while racing in close quarters to the end. LIME TRYST tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, shifted out on the far turn, was fanned five wide racing through the stretch but continued willingly to the end while being just outkicked by the top pair. SUGAR KATE tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight, steadily moved to challenge three deep on the far turn, gained the advantage racing into upper stretch, ducked in sharply near midstretch crossing the eventual winner's path and just failed to sustain her momentum. DAVID'S LUCKY LADY settled into stride along the inside in early stages tracking well off the second flight, shifted out six wide racing through upper stretch and continued in an effort to improve position. CALL ME CLASSY settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention while passing some tiring foes late. JUST WAITING broke slowly, was settled near the inside but never gained contention. ART OF DECEPTION joined the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, prompted the leader racing to the far turn and gave way between foes leaving midstretch. LOST FRIEND, urged to the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin under pressure to the second bend and emptied out racing into upper stretch.
