SIXTEEN GAUGE raced four wide near the middle of the field, rallied to the lead in the stretch and drew clear. WINCHESTER BAY set the pace from the inside while pressed then could not handle the winner in the final furlong. CAN'T SPELL raced close up three wide and put a head in front in the stretch but flattened out. HIGH PAY pressed the pace from off the rail and weakened. GARTH R lacked speed and improved his position. ROARING HOME raced close up inside, steadied on the backstretch and weakened. TEJANO TAYLOR raced off the rail and was not a factor.
