MULATA, reserved in last near the inside in the opening half, shifted outside foes nearing the far turn, steadily circled into contention four deep on the second bend, shifted out six wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to prevail in time under steady handling. BELOVEDA, off last, was urged to gain a tracking position between foes just off the second flight, shifted out advancing three deep on the far turn, swung five wide entering upper stretch and continued with a steady bid to prevail for place honors while not quite matching the winner's kick. RAILLERY stalked just off and outside the pacesetter in the opening stages, pressed the issue to gain a narrow advantage racing into the far turn but failed to sustain her momentum in the final furlong. POBRECITA tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted inwards entering upper stretch to split foes along

the inside nearing the furlong marker but was outkicked. SEALAUNCH settled along the inside racing to the backstretch, steadied off rivals when racing in close quarters midway through the backstretch, continued near the inside to upper stretch and produced a belated response racing between foes to improve her position. LUCKY GAL tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, advanced three deep after a half to make a brief bid on the far turn but flattened out leaving midstretch. MY BARBS, reserved along the inside racing just off the second flight, was caught in close quarters while continuing in hand midway through the backstretch and couldn't produce the needed closing response. NAUGHTY AND NICE was urged to the fore, dictated the pace on a narrow margin just off the inside racing to backstretch, continued to dispute the issue racing into the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch. BERRY KNOLL, caught in tight quarters early, shifted outside foes racing to the backstretch to make a brief, four wide bid entering the second bend but quickly emptied out. COUNTRY CAUCUS, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, was steadied sharply when racing rank through the first turn, continued fighting restraint racing into the backstretch and steadily retreated after a half.
