Footnotes

LAKE IN THE SKY gained a position in the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance under pressure racing through the far turn, shifted out three wide in upper stretch while moving to wrest command and drew away in late stages under steady encouragement. EXPLOSIVE DART, bumped at the start, was reserved along the inside for a half, shifted out on the far turn to split foes three deep leaving upper stretch while bumping DONTBETELLINME but continued with interest between foes to prove best of the others. NO RETREAT broke inwards bumping EXPLOSIVE DART, was righted to gain a position in the second flight, steadied a bit off DONTBETELLINME entering the first turn, continued outside a rival in the second flight to the far turn, was fanned five wide entering upper stretch but continued with a mild bid in that path to prevail for a share. DONTBETELLINME, caught wide in the opening furlong, angled inwards nearing the first turn momentarily impeding a rival while gaining terms with the first flight, raced on terms with those foes three deep into the far turn, steadily lost position to the leaders nearing upper stretch and was bumped leaving the furlong marker while outkicked for a share. MYA FACCIA BELLA sped to the lead along the inside racing to the first turn, dueled for command on the far turn into upper stretch and gave out late. DANI NIKKI tracked off the second flight near the inside early, shifted out midway through the backstretch, came around foes racing into upper stretch, shifted out six wide racing through the lane but made an effort to improve her position. BABY POLLY was urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace racing to the backstretch, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. LOOKINATMINDY, unhurried saving ground in the opening stages, switched outside foes on the backstretch, was caught four wide racing through the far turn and offered no rally while finishing seven wide racing through the stretch. JOEY'S SUPRISE, reserved along the inside in the opening half, briefly advanced to contention inside foes leaving the far turn, but finished in hand along the rail in the final furlong when lacking a path from which to challenge. J J'SSTORMBDANCING hopped at the start, was unable to track off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch but soon dropped out of contention.
