**Footnotes**

MULATA, reserved just out of striking distance outside a rival in second flight racing to the backstretch, was checked entering the second bend when losing her path to FORTHELONGHAUL while dropping well off the leaders, swung five wide entering upper stretch, then produced a sharp late response to wrest command in time despite jumping some tracks and shifting inwards in late stages. HELLO JAKE was urged to secure a forward placing along the inside racing into the first turn, shifted outside the pacesetter on the backstretch while moving to terms with that foe, pressed the issue on the far turn to gain a clear advantage in upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner's final bid. UNDER THE RIM tracked the leaders under light rating inside foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, saved ground on the second bend, then shifted out in upper stretch to continue with a mild bid between foes while edging a rival for a share. JAZZ ODYSSEY settled off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, swung four wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress to close the gap. PURE POLISHED, a bit rank under restraint tracking off the first flight in the opening stages, continued outside foes leading the second flight to the far turn, lodged a brief bid three deep racing through the far turn but lacked the needed final response. FORTHELONGHAUL bobbed at the start, was righted to track off the second flight off the inside in the opening half, shifted in nearing the second bend under prompting to advance while crossing the path of the eventual winner, continued under pressure between foes near the inside racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. PRETTY SLIC CHICK was hustled to the lead outside foes from the break, set the pace on a narrow margin along the inside into the second bend, briefly disputed the issue leaving the far turn but gave way leaving midstretch. LUCKY GAL, reserved off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out three wide on the far turn while being urged to advance but came up empty in the drive. SIN BIN was never a factor.
