**Footnotes**

BIG BAD MIKE, held up avoiding tight quarters at the start, continued under reserve racing into the first turn avoiding some traffic, made steady progress outside foes nearing the far turn, swung four wide on the second bend while moving into striking position and produced a steady late response to reel in CAPTAIN JACK on the wire under firm handling. The latter was hustled to the lead while angling over sharply racing into the first turn, set the pace on a clear margin racing into the far turn, held sway past the furlong marker and just failed to contain the winner. SANDIA CREST, caught four wide racing into the first turn while under some prompting to gain a contending position while avoiding some traffic, tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight through the backstretch, split foes then shifted inwards nearing upper stretch and continued willingly along the rail to late stages to close the gap. KIDS GAME urged three deep between foes advancing in tight quarters racing into the first turn, moved to a position just off the pacesetter while in pursuit of that foe racing through the backstretch into the far turn and came up empty nearing the furlong marker. GRAZIE, buffeted between foes while urged to contending position racing into the first turn, tracked just off the second flight along the inside to the second bend, then shifted out while continuing evenly in

late stages. GHETTO CAT, reserved well off the field in the opening stages, angled six wide racing into the stretch to gain some position while making no impression on the leaders. BRAID, bumped from both sides and shuffled back racing into the first turn, tracked the leaders out of striking distance along the inside to the far turn but offered no rally. MEADOWS REWARD, urged to contend inside foes racing into the first turn, exchanged some contact with GRAZIE, continued inside foes in the second flight tracking the pacesetter to the far turn and gave way racing into upper stretch. OUTLINE, bumped from both sides, then squeezed back racing into the first turn, was righted to track outside foes racing off the second flight to the far turn but had no rally. SHOTGUN LUKE was steadied in traffic, then forced wide avoiding foes racing into the turn, soon dropped out of contention, was pulled up leaving the far turn and walked off the course under his own power.
