### Footnotes

SWEET LUCA was rated tracking the leaders outside a rival from out of striking distance racing into the bend, was carried out by FOUR LEFT FEET racing into upper stretch but continued with a steady late bid to just edge WORK ALL WEEK in the final stages under firm left handed encouragement. The latter was urged to dispute the pace along the inside from the break, shook clear racing into upper stretch, shifted out racing through the lane while resisting the winner's bid to the end and just failed to contain that foe. FOUR LEFT FEET tracked the leaders out of striking distance along the inside racing into the turn, switched out with a sharp move nearing the quarter mile marker carrying out the winner, then was fanned five wide in the final stages while continuing with interest for a share. SACRED GIFT settled outside foes in the opening stages, altered course to the rail avoiding some traffic racing into upper stretch but had no closing bid. NAGYS PIGGY BANK, urged along prompting the pacesetter in the opening stages, pressed that foe through the turn and gave way abruptly nearing midstretch.
