GRANDMA'S RULES, in touch between foes in the opening stages, was rated in hand stalking the pacesetter outside a rival racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady bid to gain even terms with that foe racing into upper stretch and edged forward in the last furlong under brisk handling. HOOH WHY shifted to the inside early tracking the pacesetter just inside the eventual winner in the opening half, shifted out of close quarters to split foes racing into the stretch and continued with interest between foes to narrowly prevail for place honors while making some contact with DRAMA DRAMA in the closing stages. DRAMA DRAMA tracked just off the second flight along the inside in the opening half flight, shifted out three wide nearing upper stretch while moving to striking position and continued willingly to the end while just missing for second while being bumped nearing the wire. DOLL DREAMS moved to the fore while inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to upper stretch but weakened in late stages. MULATA broke slowly, settled off rivals to the far turn, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress. JOHARMONY was settled outside a rival tracking off the second flight, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and steadily retreated.
