**Footnotes**

CODOY angled to the rail in the opening stages tracking off the second flight under reserve in the opening half, continued under patient handling while steadily gathering momentum on the far turn, swung out with a sharp move to challenge four wide racing into upper stretch and wrested command in time under firm handling. VOUCH FOR VICTORY moved to the fore along the inside from the outset, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the second bend, held sway under pressure into upper stretch but yielded to the winner late. KING ROOTIN TOOTIN, reserved while guided to the inside in the opening stages racing well out of striking position, shifted out splitting foes racing through the far turn while moving to contention, shifted out to bid three deep between foes and continued with a mild gain between foes to the end. HOODWINKED, within striking distance three deep tracking just off the leaders in the opening half, moved to press the issue outside the pacesetter racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. MY JOKESTER angled to the rail in early stages to track the leaders inside foes in the second flight, saved ground throughout and finished evenly in late stages. DIXIE CREEK attended the pace between foes racing to the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch. CANDY TRAIN tracked the leaders three deep in second flight racing to the far turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. GROOM was never a factor. DOMINANT SUH tracked the pace between foes in the second flight for six furlongs and emptied out nearing upper stretch.
