**Footnotes**

DISTANT BUGLE was urged from between foes to force the pace outside a rival racing through the backstretch, gained the advantage nearing the bend, forged clear racing into upper stretch and was kept to steady pressure to extend the advantage. TILLO, urged to terms with a rival on the pace near the inside racing into the turn, couldn't match terms with the winner racing into the stretch but held well for second. TRUST MORE tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, shifted four, then five wide leaving the far turn while making steady progress and continued well enough to prevail for a share. CUARTO CUATES tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight, shifted out to bid between foes nearing upper stretch, then continued evenly in late stages. JUST CRUISEN ON bobbed at the start, was held up off the second flight along the inside racing to the bend, continued near the inside

approaching upper stretch and finished evenly in late stages. CATCH THE TRAIN broke readily, tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, was caught four wide between foes nearing upper stretch while under pressure to advance but steadily faded in the drive. FEAR NOR FAVOR was settled between foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. COWBOY JONES tracked off the second flight near the inside early but never mounted a serious challenge. OLD LOW DOWN was a brief factor between foes in the second flight but retreated from contention early. IN ALL DIRECTIONS was never a factor. WINDY CITY LEAL trailed throughout.
