**Footnotes**

WILD PANTERA shifted a bit off the inside tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance as part of the second flight racing through the backstretch, moved to split foes entering the turn to challenge for command midway through the bend, forged clear racing into upper stretch and was kept to steady pressure. DODIE JO was settled in last racing to the turn, angled four wide nearing upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to prove best of the others. MYSTIC BEACH tracked the leaders outside foes just off the second flight, shifted inwards a bit on the turn, switched out entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve position while earning a share. HEATED DEBATE tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight early, was caught four wide racing into the turn while being prompted to challenge in tandem with the eventual winner but steadily faded nearing midstretch. BEYYA tracked the leaders between foes in second flight, moved to challenge three deep between rivals entering the turn but came up empty entering upper stretch. MALI tracked just off the pacesetter along the rail in the opening half but steadily faded from contention on the turn. SATURDAY ROMP was urged to the fore outside a rival in the opening stages, set the pace on a clear margin racing into the turn and emptied out early.
