Footnotes

BOWMANS CASTLE was settled off the second flight near the inside in the opening half, steadily advanced to striking distance in tandem with several rivals while just off the inside racing through the turn, switched out splitting foes leaving the quarter mile marker to challenge four wide and edged forward in late stages under firm handling. BLUE CANOE was settled in last while angling to the rail in early stages, commenced a steady advance inside foes on the turn, drew into striking distance entering upper stretch, steadied momentarily in close quarters approaching the furlong marker but continued under firm handling nearest the rail to edge several rivals for place honors while being outfinished by the winner. NUCKSER sped to the fore a bit off the inside setting the pace on a clear margin, shifted to the inside racing into the turn, resisted when challenged while racing between foes through upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. LUV BANDIT tracked just off the pacesetter under light rating in the opening stages, made steady progress to challenge that foe racing into upper stretch, continued three deep between rivals but lacked the needed final kick. RIVERSHIRE settled off the second flight outside foes, gradually drew into contention after six furlongs while being fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and was making mild progress to close the gap. DOMAIN'S RAP tracked off the first flight under rating while shifting off the inside, bid three deep between foes nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. FAST ALBERT shifted out tracking the leaders as part of the second flight, was caught four wide between foes while being urged to advance nearing upper stretch but quickly emptied out.
