Footnotes

GOLDSWISH, prominent between foes from the outset, angled to the rail once establishing a clear advantage dictating the pace on a narrow margin, edged clear on the turn, was headed nearing midstretch but produced a solid second effort to regain the advantage in time under firm left handed encouragement. COSTLY KING, in close attendance to the pace along the inside in the opening stages, tracked the leaders along the rail racing into the turn, switched outside the pacesetter nearing upper stretch while being urged to challenge that foe, gained the advantage midstretch but couldn't put the winner away. GOLD DOUBLE tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages but continued with a steady four wide advance to gain some position racing into the stretch. C. C. BANJO broke slowly, settled well off the field, split foes racing into upper stretch, then shifted five wide while finding his best stride late to improve position. BACKDOC settled along the inside early, shifted out nearing the lane to race six wide in the stretch but made some belated progress to improve position. JUST CRUISEN ON tracked the pace between foes off the second flight, steadied in close quarters midway through the turn and couldn't

make a serious impression while continuing evenly into the stretch. ON THE RUN tracked off the second flight while angling inwards a bit, shifted out four wide racing into the lane but had no rally. WINDY CITY LEAL worked his way to the inside racing into the turn but never gained contention. GIBBY'S TORNADO tracked the pace between foes in second flight early, angled to the rail entering the turn but steadily faded racing into stretch. HARBOR JUNIOR joined the pace between foes from the outset, pressed outside the winner racing into the bend and gave way entering upper stretch. EMMA BABY never seriously menaced. RICHIE'S LIFESTYLE, in touch with the leaders four deep early, tracked the leaders as part of the second flight into the bend and gave way after a half.
