Footnotes

SPORTING GENT gained a position tracking the first flight a bit off the inside while under firm rating in the opening half, continued under light reserve splitting foes on the bend to challenge inside the pacesetter nearing upper stretch, wrested a clear advantage in the lane and extended the margin under firm right handed encouragement. JACOB'S LIGHTHOUSE settled between foes in the last flight early, angled to the rail nearing the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and came through close quarters to edge several rivals for place honors. KID CHIC tracked off the first flight five wide in the opening stages, made steady progress in that path to challenge for command nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. BROKEN BOW tracked off the second flight between foes, angled to the inside entering the turn, made some progress to gain position nearing the lane and continued evenly between foes late. REGGVILLE tracked off the second flight three wide between foes racing into the turn, was fanned six wide entering the stretch and continued evenly late. CLOUT, a bit slow into stride, shifted out five wide splitting foes racing into the stretch but made no real impression. BANDINI'S DREAM was urged to press the pace between foes soon after the break, dueled for command racing into the turn and gave way midstretch when failing to match the winner.

MOST DISTINCT, in touch with the first flight four deep in the opening stages, pressed the issue in that path racing into the turn and gave way racing into upper stretch. GAELIC BREEZE vied for the lead three deep between foes racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. LEFT FIRST tracked the leaders just out of striking distance six wide in the opening stages but steadily faded from contention on the turn. RAJABLOU broke slowly, was hustled up the rail to gain the advantage after the opening quarter, pressed inside foes racing into the bend and emptied out abruptly after five furlongs.
