Footnotes

PI BELLA went readily to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace under stout restraint into the far turn, then responded when urged to move well clear of her foes in upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. MULATA swerved out at the start, was taken in hand, then settled along the inside, continued unhurried into the far turn, angled out to split foes four wide in late stages and prevailed for the place. MONASHEE ROSE, carried out a bit by JO'S FINALE while under some reserve racing into the first turn, continued under rating off the inside, was fanned five deep racing through the stretch but continued to improve her position. MOUNTAIN FELIX, reserved in second flight outside a rival in the opening half, advanced to challenge three deep racing through the far turn and flattened out. UNDER THE RIM angled inwards to stalk just outside the leader racing to the backstretch, pressed the pace between foes into upper stretch and quickly faded when failing to match terms with the winner. JO'S FINALE shifted off the inside racing into the first turn while drifting into a rival's path, made a brief, four wide after a half and steadily retreated on the far turn. JABBER DABBER DOO was held up tracking just off the leaders along the inside, but came up empty leaving the far turn.
