Footnotes

RIVER OF NO RETURN, bumped at the start, was guided to the inside settling out of striking distance racing into the first turn, made steady progress inside foes to gain position entering the far turn, shifted out three wide nearing upper stretch and continued with a sustained response to just edge CARTOUCHE in time under pressure. The latter broke readily to gain a narrow advantage along the inside racing into the first turn, attended the pace inside a rival for six furlongs, forced the issue racing through the far turn, edged forward to a clear advantage entering upper stretch and just failed to contain the winner. SHIP'S CABIN, prominent between foes from the outset, pulled his way to the lead after the opening quarter to dictate the pace on a narrow margin while under rating, pressed the issue outside a rival racing into the far turn and emptied out entering upper stretch while continuing well enough to prevail for a share. GRACIAS DERENZO, off slowly, was settled along the inside racing to the far turn, made steady progress inside foes on the second bend, then shifted out three deep in the last furlong while continuing to improve his position. NINTH CLIENT, in close attendance to the pace three deep in the opening quarter, dropped off the leaders entering the backstretch, worked his way to the inside, then made a second effort racing inside foes to upper stretch to gain some position. SWEETEST RHYTHM was settled off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch, continued three and four deep through the far turn and faded nearing upper stretch. JUMP RIGHT IN shifted off the inside avoiding close quarters racing to the backstretch tracking just off the first flight, continued three and four deep on the backstretch, then steadily faded from contention racing through the far turn. CHIEF BEAR broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, was reserved in hand off the inside racing to the backstretch and offered no rally.
