Footnotes

PINE MAST moved to the fore along the inside to secure a narrow advantage while in hand racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin under light rating to the far turn, was roused to turn back a challenge from COPPER FOREST racing into upper stretch and drew clear late under steady handling. MAGIC BULLET, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, swung out four wide racing through the far turn commencing his advance, continued in that path to upper stretch and proved best of the others. COPPER FOREST, on terms with the eventual winner from the break, attended the pace outside that foe under some reserve racing to the backstretch, moved to press the issue racing into upper stretch but proved no match in the final sixteenth. STANLEY G., reserved between foes just off the second flight racing to the backstretch, came through close quarters splitting rivals midway through the far turn to challenge three deep between foes entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. WHERE'S WINSTON, held up just off the leaders along the inside tracking the pace racing to the far turn, steadily weakened nearing upper stretch. BOBBY SANDS tracked unhurried just off the leaders racing three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, advanced in that path to make a brief bid entering the far turn but flattened out after six furlongs. PLYMOUTH BAY, allowed to settle in the opening half, never mounted a serious challenge.
