### Footnotes

ASTUTE, unhurried four deep in the second flight in the opening furlong, commenced a sharp advance in that path entering the first turn to wrest command after the opening quarter, shifted to the inside entering the backstretch dictating the pace on a clear margin, maintained that advantage into the second bend and drew away racing into upper stretch while being kept to steady right handed encouragement. KETTLE CORN, held up inside foes in the second flight while pulling a bit in the opening stages, shifted out midway through the backstretch, switched out three and four wide racing into the far turn while making steady progress, continued three deep into upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors. HARVEST HOME, forwardly placed along the rail racing into the first turn, shifted off the inside entering the backstretch tracking just off the pacesetter, chased that foe on the far turn into upper stretch and weakened in the drive while lasting for a share. I AM THE SHERIFF angled inwards while being reserved off the second flight in the opening stages, was roused to advance near the inside entering the far turn, came through close quarters splitting foes midway though the second bend, angled to the rail to challenge in upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. LEAD THE WAY tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight early, angled to the inside entering the backstretch, briefly advanced to contention inside foes entering the far turn but quickly emptied out nearing upper stretch. LALO'S BABY BEAR, in close attendance to the pace three deep in the opening quarter, tracked outside foes racing through the backstretch and steadily retreated entering the far turn. L'AIGLON tracked the leaders unhurried three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch but quickly dropped out nearing the far turn. AFRICAN MOON, close up between foes in the first flight racing to the backstretch, was steadied a bit near the seven furlong marker, continued to track the pace three wide on the backstretch and stopped abruptly entering the far turn.
