Footnotes

CALL TO GLORY broke readily, stalked just off a rival under light rating racing through the backstretch, moved to press the issue on the turn, gained the advantage nearing upper stretch, then continued with a game effort to turn back the challenge of SWORD AND SHIELD in the closing stages while shifting out into that rival's path in late stages. The latter tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight in the opening half, shifted three deep nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance, drew even with the leader nearing midstretch but was outfinished. LEMON CUSTARD tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail from behind the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch to gain some position, then angled inwards in the final sixteenth while continuing to close the gap. JIMMY GOT EVEN, held up off the first flight racing a bit off the inside tracking the leaders inside a rival racing into the turn, was urged to challenge between foes but lacked the needed closing bid. BOSCO RULES moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break to dictate the pace on a narrow margin, disputed the lead into upper stretch and gave way. SICOMORO was settled in hand outside foes off the second flight in the opening stages and dropped out nearing upper stretch.
