LOCK N LOLA was urged between foes in the opening stages to gain terms with the first flight, pressed the issue outside a rival into upper stretch, then asserted herself in the final stages to edge forward under firm handling. STELLAR PRIZE moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break, disputed the lead with a rival racing into upper stretch and resisted that foe to late stages while proving second best. HORSCHER angled inwards a bit while under some reserve to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight racing through the backstretch, shifted out to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, but couldn't gain terms with the top pair while continuing well enough to prevail for a share. LAKE SHORE GRACE, prominent outside foe in the opening stages, dropped off the second flight while outside foes racing into the turn, but produced a second effort racing four wide into upper stretch to gain some position. DEVOUT DIVA tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn, came under pressure nearing upper stretch but faded in the drive. AFLEET ABACO shifted out in the opening stages, was settled three deep in the last flight racing to the turn, was fanned six wide entering upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. HONEY UNLIMITED tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail in the last flight racing to the turn but never gained striking distance. YORONA settled between foes in the last flight in the opening stages, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch but never seriously menaced. LEWDERHOO tracked the pace outside foes off the second flight in the opening stages but steadily faded racing into the stretch. LADY JOBURG stumbled badly at the start losing her rider, was collected by the outrider after the race and walked off the course under her own power. THE HALF MILE
