### Footnotes

ROMO TIME broke sharply, was sent clear along the inside racing to the backstretch, then held sway on a comfortable margin to late stages while being kept to pressure. LOVERBIL swerved out at the start impeding SHOT AN A GOAL while crossing into the path of SILVER ROCK STAR, was collected, then angled to the rail tracking the pacesetter inside foes racing to the far turn, came out in upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to close the gap late. WASHINGTON DASH settled off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out to split foes three wide racing into upper stretch and was making steady progress to the end. EMPIRE TAKER tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, moved to challenge while being fanned four wide racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. COOL STREET settled into stride near the inside early and made some mild progress in late stages to improve position. SILVER ROCK STAR was steadied off LOVERBIL at the start, advanced four deep racing into the backstretch to gain a contending position, continued outside foes while being fanned five wide entering the stretch and had no final bid. HEY JAY tracked off the second flight along the rail racing to the far turn but lacked the needed late response. TRICKEROY angled inwards to stalk the pacesetter leading the second flight in the opening half, moved to challenge between foes nearing upper stretch but emptied out in the drive. SHOT AN A GOAL, pinched back at the start, trailed throughout.
