SNAPPED, reserved off the second flight while shifting to the rail early, continued in that position into the second bend, swung five wide entering upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command and kick clear late under firm left handed encouragement. MCLARD pulled his way to contention soon after the break while shifting off the inside, prompted the pacesetter racing into the far turn, dueled between foes into upper stretch, couldn't fend off the winner's bid but held grudgingly for second. FREE FIGHTER, held up along the inside racing in second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out three wide in upper stretch to bid between foes but was outkicked by the top pair. CABERNEIGH was rated just off the leaders outside a rival as part of the second flight racing to the second bend, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch while being roused to challenge but was outkicked for a share. PRAIRIE BREEZE settled outside a rival off the second flight in the opening half, angled out six wide racing through the stretch while displaying some late interest. CROSS VILLAGE was urged to secure the lead while shifting in racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on his own courage through the backstretch, briefly disputed the lead inside a rival on the far turn but emptied out nearing midstretch.
