DENIM gained a contending position between foes racing to the first turn, tracked the pacesetter from out of striking distance a bit off the inside under light rating for a half, steadily drew into contention while shifting out three deep on the far turn, moved to challenge in that path between foes nearing midstretch, then took over in late stages, edging clear under firm handling. TIZ A SCHOLAR, held up when carried in a bit by THE ALCOVA KID at the start, settled well off the second flight for a half, made steady progress four wide on the far turn advancing to contention, was fanned five wide into the stretch but continued with interest to prevail for place honors. INVISIBLE STAR settled off the second flight along the rail racing to the backstretch, shifted out nearing upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position four deep between foes while prevailing for a share. STANLEY G. tracked off the second flight three deep racing to the backstretch, continued in that path while moving to challenge between foes racing into upper stretch and was just outkicked for a share. OUTLAW MAN raced unhurried between foes behind the second flight in the opening half, made some progress to lodge his bid near the inside entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. CORNWHISKEY tracked the pacesetter from just out of striking position racing to the backstretch, closed the gap on that foe to gain brief command racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. JOHNNY CADILLAC settled well off the field racing to the backstretch and never seriously menaced. THE ALCOVA KID broke inwards crossing a rival's path, was steadied off that foe and never menaced thereafter. STARK RAVIN MAD bobbed at the start, was quickly righted, sprinted clear along the rail racing into the backstretch to open a commanding margin but emptied out abruptly nearing upper stretch.
