BETTER MAKE MONEY was settled off the second flight six wide while in hand in the opening stages, steadily gathered momentum racing into upper stretch while being fanned seven wide and found his best stride late to wrest command in that path nearing the wire while under firm encouragement. DIXIE BANNER tracked off the first flight outside a rival from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, made steady progress drawing into range three deep nearing upper stretch, moved to wrest command approaching the furlong marker and just failed to contain the winner. MILWAUKEE WOLF tracked off the second flight along the inside racing into the bend, shifted out to split foes three deep in upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to the end to

prevail for a share. DICTUM tracked the pace outside foes behind the the second flight racing to the turn, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance but lacked the needed final kick. SHORTY SMALL was roused to the lead from the break while angling inwards racing to the turn, shook clear nearing upper stretch, drifted in approaching the furlong marker and quickly gave way once headed. IZZY GOLDEN tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance inside a rival in the second flight, steadily drew into contention along the rail racing into upper stretch, was checked off a tiring pacesetter nearing the furlong marker and lacked any further response. TURNPIKE TOMMY broke slowly, was righted to make some progress four deep between foes racing into the turn, was fanned six wide while between foes into upper stretch and lacked the needed late response. TWYLAS RED CAT tracked the leaders between foes behind the second flight racing into the turn, angled out five wide in upper stretch but lacked a further response. KING A. J., bumped at the start, was settled along the inside in the opening stages and never gained contention. REPENT N RECEIVE joined the pace outside a rival soon after the start, forced the issue racing into the turn and was through after a half. RUN WITH EAGLES was never a factor. WINNING WILDCAT broke outwards bumping KING A. J. at the start, was steadied slightly off that foe and trailed the field to stretch.
