AFLEET PADDY, reserved in hand in the opening stages while shifting off the inside, commenced a steady advance outside foes nearing the far turn, circled foes four deep racing into upper stretch to gain terms with the pacesetter, took over from that foe and drew clear late under firm left handed encouragement. ROCKET RICHIE moved to the fore along the inside while under light rating in the opening stages, turned back several challengers racing into the far turn to gain a clear advantage racing into upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. WELL EXCUUUZE ME tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, was shuffled in traffic midway through the far turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch and continued to improve his position while gaining a share. BIG POPPA D, reserved along the inside in the opening half, shifted out to split foes three deep on the far turn, swung four wide nearing upper stretch and continued willingly while improving his position. SCORE BABY SCORE worked his way to the inside tracking just off the pacesetter but came up empty racing through the far turn. ESPRESSO settled off the second flight racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. HOLY FEVER tracked the leaders three deep in second flight under some reserve in the opening stages, moved to make a brief challenge in that path nearing the far turn but quickly emptied out. BERNARDUS stalked just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, moved to press the issue between foes nearing the far turn but quickly retreated after six furlongs.
