Footnotes

MOONBIE tracked just off the first flight in the opening stages while within easy striking distance, commenced a steady advance nearing the turn while switching outside foes, bid three deep for command after a half, wrested command leaving midstretch and just held the challenge of HOMEBOYKRIS under brisk handling. The latter tracked the leaders unhurried from just out of striking distance along the inside, swung four wide racing into upper stretch while being roused to challenge and produced a steady late response to close the gap in the final sixteenth. STREAMIN HEAT broke sharply, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, briefly resisted the winner's challenge but weakened in late stages. PRIDEOFTHECHAPTER settled into stride off the inside early, angled in nearing the turn and made some mild progress along the inside in late stages. SHIP FROM ABROAD chased the pacesetter into the turn but emptied out nearing upper stretch when failing to gain terms with that foe. SMILES AHEAD, a bit slow into stride, trailed throughout.
