EDITORS RANSOM settled along the inside then was boxed in through the turn and angled out at the top of the stretch to get up in the final stride. STAGE GLITTER raced close up while three wide then ranged to the lead coming off the turn and was set down for the long drive but was outnodded. CHEYENNE SPIRIT raced close up along the inside then headed the leader at the top of the stretch but couldn't go on. SYND dropped back early and saved ground then made a belated bid between horses. DANCY'S ANGEL got off slowly then was asked between horses heading into the turn but flattened out. OTHER LADY rated in the middle of the pack with a wide trip but made no rally. NO IMAGE set the pace and battled to the stretch then tired late.
