### Footnotes

OUTLAW ZEN tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance along the inside, shifted three deep after a half commencing a steady advance, took over in upper stretch and just maintained his advantage under firm handling. SUCHAFOOL tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail in the opening quarter, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, altered course four deep leaving the three sixteenth marker and produced his best stride late to just miss. SOUTHERN MUDD tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight, then continued evenly three deep racing through the stretch to earn a share. WINDY CITY LEAL ducked out at the start, was a bit outpaced early, shifted off the inside entering upper stretch and made some belated progress outside foes. BUSY LAD broke slowly, was settled along the inside but couldn't gain striking distance. CAPTAIN PIEVO went up from the break to prompt the pace outside a rival racing to the bend, shook clear midway through the turn but faltered entering upper stretch. CAP'N FELIX was hustled to the lead along the inside, dueled for command racing into the turn and gave way after three furlongs.
