CROSS VILLAGE was settled in hand while angling inwards a bit racing to the first turn, made steady progress to gain terms with the leaders while shifting out four wide entering upper stretch, wrested command with a sharp move in late stages and drew clear under pressure. SNAKE RIVER CANYON angled inwards to stalk the pacesetter along the inside to the far turn, shifted out to challenge that foe entering upper stretch, but proved no match for the winner. SNAPPED tracked the just off the pacesetter along the inside in the opening half, awaited an opening racing nearest the rail in upper stretch, then came through close quarters in late stages to secure a share. TRIPP O STEEL dictated the pace from the outset while under rating, held sway to midstretch and gave way. TUCKY tracked the pace between foes unhurried in the opening stages, shifted out leaving the far turn and continued with a mild bid. TURNPIKE TOMMY tracked the leader outside a rival in second flight to the far turn but soon came up empty. YEP was settled along the inside and never gained contention. JANSDREAM never seriously menaced.
