PANAMA HAT, reserved near the inside from out of striking distance in the opening half, gathered momentum entering the turn while shifting off the inside, swung five wide nearing upper stretch while drawing on terms with the first flight, took over in upper stretch and extended his margin to the end under firm left handed encouragement. LIGHTNING BLUE worked his way to the inside gaining a position in the second flight in the opening stages, came through inside the leaders when presented an opening nearing the quarter mile marker to challenge for command in tandem with several rivals, couldn't match the winner's final bid but proved clearly best of the others. GREYHAWK went up from the break to prompt the pace outside a rival racing to the turn, dueled between foes into the stretch, weakened when failing to match terms with the to pair but shifted out in the closing stages to prevail for a share. DISTANT BUGLE tracked the leaders outside a rival while maintaining striking distance in the opening half, moved to challenge midway through the turn while angling out four wide, bid between foes in that path racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. RICH THUNDER was urged to dispute the pace along the inside racing into the bend, shifted a bit off the inside nearing the quarter mile marker and gave way in upper stretch. PIECEOFTHEACTION, bumped soundly start, was settled off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages and offered no rally. MR. MINIVER swerved outwards bumping PIECEOFTHEACTION at the start, was collected off that foe to race in hand between rivals and soon trailed.
