Footnotes

NEWPORT, reserved off the second flight along the rail in the opening half, shifted off the inside entering the far turn, switched outside foes leaving the midway point of the second bend to challenge five wide racing into upper stretch, then wrested command and drew clear in late stages under strong handling. HUCKLEBERRY BOY, urged to secure a forward placing, led the second flight outside a rival into the backstretch while tracking the pacesetter from out of striking position under some reserve, continued with a steady bid to gain a narrow advantage entering the far turn, was roused to repel the winner racing into upper stretch but proved no match while clearly second best. SAM OWEN, held up off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out leaving the backstretch to race between foes while gaining striking distance, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted to the inside in upper stretch to gain a share in late stages but had no final kick. WISTFUL SMILE, angled inwards a bit in the opening stages settling well off the pace, made some progress between foes on the far turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued to improve his placing. MISTER THAYER broke inwards bumping UNO PECADOR, gained a position outside foes tracking off the second flight, made some progress to gain contention while racing four wide through the far turn but steadily faded in the drive. SILVER EMBER was settled along the inside in the opening stages and never gained contention. PHOENIX FORCE, caught four wide racing into the first turn while racing off the second flight, never mounted a serious challenge. MANO

POINT was urged to secure a forward placing while angling to the inside, raced as part of the second flight into the far turn, steadied off a tiring foe midway through the far turn and steadily faded. UNO PECADOR, bumped, then shuffled a bit at the start, was urged between foes to gain a contending position three deep just off the second flight racing into the backstretch, made a brief bid between foes in that path entering the far turn but quickly emptied out. BLUSHING PREACHER tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch but never seriously menaced. STAR RATING sprinted clear into the backstretch opening a commanding margin but emptied out quickly after being headed racing through the far turn.
