Footnotes

GULF BLVD broke readily while making some light contact with CARTIAC ARREST, was urged to secure the lead along the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, moved clear under a few right handed taps in upper stretch and extended the advantage in late stages under firm hand urging. ZUNI WOMEN broke in the air losing some position to the field, tracked off the second flight along the inside early, shifted out three deep entering the turn advancing between foes to challenge racing into upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner but proved best of the others. CARTIAC ARREST, brushed at the start, was guided to the rail stalking just off the pacesetter under light reserve racing to the turn, saved ground throughout and continued willingly in late stages to gain a share. RUNAWAY ABACO tracked off the first flight four deep racing to the turn, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. WAPANUCKA broke sharply, was urged along prompting the pacesetter racing into the turn, couldn't match that foe after a half and gave way midstretch. BOLD STREET CAT tracked the leaders three deep between foes in second flight racing into the turn, was fanned four wide nearing upper stretch and quickly faded entering upper stretch.
