Footnotes

LADY CHESTERFIELD gained a position just off the leaders near the inside in the opening stages, was switched outside after the opening furlong avoiding tight quarters, continued outside a rival in the second flight advancing on the leaders, moved to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch and wore down TATY'S GOLD to prevail narrowly in time under firm handling. The latter joined the pace outside a rival while shifting inwards a bit racing through the backstretch, pressed the issue into upper stretch to gain the advantage, then resisted the winner to the end. LITTLE NIP, held up along the inside avoiding traffic while dropping off the second flight in the opening quarter, advanced to contention along the rail racing into upper stretch and continued willingly inside the top pair to the end to contest the issue. SWEET AND LOWDOWN shifted inwards in early stages tracking just off the first flight racing into the turn but came up empty entering upper stretch. FLO'S STRAWBERRY was urged to secure the lead while angling sharply to the rail in the opening stages, dueled for command inside a rival on the turn and gave way between foes in upper stretch.
