PENELOPE PERFECT was guided to the rail in the opening stages to track off the second flight under rating racing into the backstretch, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch gathering momentum, switched out five, then six wide racing through upper stretch to split foes challenging for command, drifted inwards under pressure racing past midstretch crossing the paths of GHOST OF A CHANCE and LORI'S STORE but continued with a steady late response to edge her entrymate under firm encouragement. DELIGHTFUL DAISY was guided to the rail while prompted to gain a forward placing racing to the first turn, tracked just off the first flight along the inside into the second bend, came around a tiring foe nearing upper stretch to bid for command inside foes, gained the advantage between calls late but was collared nearing the wire. RAZZLEBERRY angled inwards to track the leaders in second flight between foes racing to the far turn, shifted out six wide entering the lane but continued willingly in that path to the end to close the gap. MADAM NANCY, held up avoiding tight quarters just after the start, tracked off the second flight between foes into the far turn, shifted out five wide racing through the stretch but continued with interest to gain some position. GHOST OF A CHANCE tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, steadily moved to striking distance four deep racing through the far turn, bid for command in that path entering upper stretch, but was forced to check losing her momentum while losing her path to PENELOPE PERFECT leaving the furlong marker. COURSER tracked just off the leaders outside foes in the second flight in the opening half, moved to challenge three deep between foes racing through the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch. LORI'S STORE, forwardly placed

outside a rival prompting that foe's pace in the opening half, moved to press the issue between foes racing through the far turn, lost the advantage leaving midstretch and was steadied avoiding close quarters while losing her path in the final stages. JALAL settled outside foes in the last flight early, was fanned seven wide racing into the stretch gaining some position but made no real impression. CONFESSION, reserved saving ground early, never gained contention. GOLDEN HARP was hustled to the lead, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the far turn and gave out abruptly entering upper stretch. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF GHOST OF A CHANCE LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF PENELOPE PERFECT FOR INTERFERENCE WHILE THE STEWARDS LODGED A CONCURRENT INQUIRY. FOLLOWING A REVIEW OF THE RACE THE STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED PENELOPE PERFECT FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HER EIGHTH.
