Footnotes

PIRATES VOW sprinted to a clear advantage while angling over in the opening stages, dictated terms to his foes to upper stretch, then surged away in late stages while being kept to steady pressure. WAKEUPBRANDON chased the pacesetter three wide into the turn as part of the second flight, continued in that path to upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. SORREL OF THE SEA shifted to the inside gaining a forward placing while bumping JAKE'S SOLDIER in the opening stages, continued to work his way to the rail racing as part of the second flight on the turn, bid inside foes in upper stretch, couldn't match the top pair and just held for a share. JAKE'S SOLDIER angled to the inside in the opening stages, was bumped, then shuffled back nearing the bend, continued along the inside tracking off the second flight, then shifted out in late stages while continuing with interest. GREY KNIGHT leaned inwards exchanging contact with NECAISE just after the start, shifted outside foes in the opening stages, swung four wide nearing upper stretch but could make no impression on the leaders. NECAISE, caught in tight quarters after the start, shifted off the inside to track between foes racing into the turn but never gained contention. LANDING CHASER ducked outwards while caught in close quarters bumping NECAISE just after the break, was steadied in traffic along the inside in the opening quarter and never menaced thereafter. CANAVERAL RIDE was a brief factor between foes in second flight but steadily faded from contention in the drive.
